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SCHOOL AND COMMUNITY

St. John's International School provides an English-speaking education that is values-based, encourages academic excellence and stimulates social development within a culturally diverse environment. St. John's was founded in 1964 and educates students from more than 56 countries in grades pre-K to 12. The class of 2019 will graduate 53 students. St. John's Middle-High School population includes students representing more than 56 countries. Waterloo is located 10 km south of Brussels, the capital of Belgium and Europe, and headquarters to the European Union and NATO.

CURRICULUM AND ACCREDITATION - GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

The school is fully accredited by the Middle States Association of Colleges and Schools, the European Council of International Schools and the International Baccalaureate Organisation. The most recent re-accreditations occurred in 2011 (IBO) and 2012 (MSACS, ECIS).

The school awards a General Diploma and an Academic Diploma. A student may also work towards the International Baccalaureate Diploma which is awarded upon successful completion of requirements set by the IB organization.

The General Diploma has the same requirements with the exception of the four elective credits.

- All students are required to complete the personal development program Creativity, Activity, Service (CAS) during their final two years.

GRADING AND RANKING

- St. John's employs a rigorous grading system closely tied to IB marks.
- Because of the nature of our transient population, the school does not rank. The GPA is an average of all courses taken at St. John's during the junior year only. An additional .33 grad point is added for IB courses.
- The school year is divided into semesters.

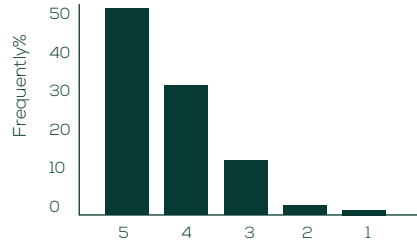

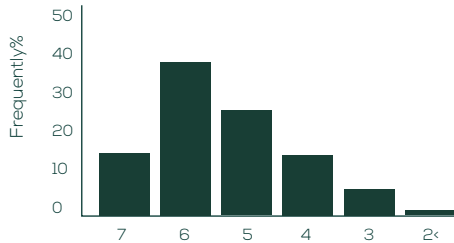
Advanced Placement

22 students sat 35 exams. 82% scored 4 or 5. 93% scored 3 or higher.



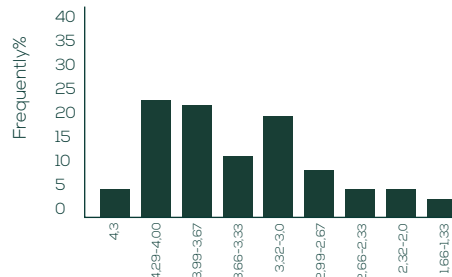
Grade Distribution
